An initiative of Community En Accion (CEA), the Young Achievers Forum (YAF) is designed to support and build the academic capacity of sixth grade students to prepare for a successful university career. While we believe the foundation for this begins in early childhood, ages 0-5; it is followed in the elementary school years, grades kindergarten through fifth grade; and by sixth grade, students should be making critical decisions about their career path in middle school and high school. Why sixth grade? This grade is a pivotal year because students need to start thinking about future careers and what courses in middle school and high school, they need to take to advance their career choice. This process plays out well with students in high socio-economic levels, however, for most students in low to mid socio-economic levels this process may not play out as described. As community members and educators, we have experienced how students at these socio-economic levels, though very smart, may not have access to the guidance and resources to prepare for a career and neither may their parents. Making these decisions in high school close to graduation may be too late for the career choice these students may want to take.

With these beliefs in mind, successful business members who form the organization Community En Accion (CEA), have taken the lead in creating the Young Achievers Forum (YAF). It begins with the concept of identifying students who have hidden or dormant potential and sponsoring a day of activities focused on inspiring and motivating these students to begin the process of thinking about their future academic career. These students and their parents are invited to attend. Students are transported to a day of awareness, inspiration, and motivation about future careers. Parents transport themselves to the event. The students and their parents are engaged in a day filled with motivational speakers and small group workshops by business leaders who introduce the students to various careers.

This day is made possible due to the volunteer work of the YAF Committee and their success in procuring donations from the community. The YAF Committee is comprised of business leaders and educators who are responsible for the planning and implementation of the Young Achievers Forum. The YAF Committee has created a cadre of community volunteers who engage in a yearlong planning process. Additionally, the YAF Committee has created a network with the area's school districts superintendents, teachers, and counselors to identify, register, and transport the students. A partnership with the University of Texas at El Paso to host the YAF so that students can be introduced to the university is an integral part of this process.



Purpose

The purpose of this report is threefold: (1) to provide information about the 2020 Young Achievers Forum including its background, design, and methodology; (2) to report detailed descriptive statistics in a series of tables regarding the response of students and parents to the day's event; and (3) to provide YAF organizers with the information needed to discern the impact of the YAF event in order to improve future events and consider possible expansion.

Methods

This report provides data about specific areas, topics, and activities that were implemented during the one-day Saturday event, Young Achievers Forum, February 22, 2020 held at the University of Texas at El Paso. Data from participating students was collected through a survey comprised of 7 multiple choice questions. This survey is included as Appendix A at the end of this report. A total of 584 individual surveys were collected and analyzed.

During the planning phase of the YAF, teachers and counselors from 48 elementary/middle schools identified, invited, and assisted sixth grade students to register for the YAF event. A flyer was provided for each invited student to take to his/her parents. This flyer explains the YAF and encourages parents to attend. This flyer is included in Appendix B at the end of this report.

The YAF event included an opening session designed to inspire and motivate students to realize that they each have G-3 – "God Given Greatness" and that the world is filled with opportunities for them. It was then followed by 5 small group workshops on various careers. Students, assigned to a 20-member group, were then led by a team ambassador to attend a series of 5 different workshops. At the end of the last workshop, students were guided to complete the survey. Students, independently, completed and submitted the survey to their team ambassador.

Participating parents attended the inspirational session and then attended a half day workshop designed to increase their awareness of the opportunities available to students to prepare for attendance to a university and the resources available to fund a university degree. At the end of the last workshop, parents were asked to complete a survey comprised of 6 multiple choice questions. The survey was in both English and Spanish with 37 parents answering in English and 10 parents answering in Spanish. The parent survey is included as Appendix C-English and Appendix D-Spanish at the end of this report.

Overview: Student Participation

Data regarding student registration, indicates that 793 students registered for the YAF event. Actual student attendance was 547. While all 12 independent school districts in El Paso and Hudspeth Counties were invited to attend, only 2 school districts did not participate. This reflects one school district from El Paso County (Fabens ISD) and one school districts from Hudspeth County (Dell City ISD). The following table outlines the 48 elementary/middle schools and the number of students who participated.

Findings: Student Survey

Research points to the fact that sixth and seventh graders are tired of filling out information because of the numerous testing that they experience. Therefore, when a survey is administered on a Saturday, it can present a risk of a low response rate or very negative feedback. However, this was different relative to YAF because most of the responses were positive. Something in the climate and motivation offered by YAF overrode something as tiresome as filling out yet another survey by the preteen participants. The evaluator was impressed with the number of useful, completed survey instruments made available for data analysis and interpretation.

Responses to the seven questions in the student survey instrument are displayed in data tables in Appendix E the end of the report. These data tables resulted from 584 responses on the student survey found in Appendix A. Described below are the evaluator's interpretation of the data.

Q-1: Was this your first time on a university campus?

Approximately 1/3 of the responding students (32%) had never been on a university campus before to YAF.

Q-2: What was the most helpful part of the YAF?

40%

The first three choices were selected by over 40% of the students, with "motivation/inspiration provided at the workshop" and "the information/ ideas provided at the workshops" identified by the vast majority of the students, 72% and 55%, respectively.

Q-3:

Before today had you ever thought about or considered attending a university?

50%

Half of the respondents (50%) indicated that they had already chosen a career to study, but 41% indicated that they had considered university studies but were "undecided as to what career to study".

Q-4:

Did the Young Achievers forum motivate you to go to a university?

96%

The vast majority of the respondents (96%) indicated that the YAF did motivate them to go to a university.

Q-5:

What would you be doing if you were not here at the Young Achievers Forum?

64%

Most of the respondents (64%) reported that they would be at home with their family. 46% indicated that they would be "sleeping late". Two other responses were also checked at 24% each – "playing sports" and "studying or doing homework". 22% of respondents reported they "would be with friends". Interesting to note is that 9% indicated that they "would be working".



Q-6:

Would you be interested in participating in more YAF activities throughout the year?

96% Nearly all respondents (96%) would be interested in participating in more YAF activities.

Q-7:

Would you recommend the Young Achievers Forum to your friends?

98%

The vast majority of the respondents (98%) would recommend the Young Achievers Forum to their friend.

Overview: Parent Participation

Parents were invited to attend the YAF alongside their children. Their participation was encouraged through the receipt of a flyer explaining the YAF event and highlighting benefits for participating students and parents.

A total of 47 parents chose to participate with 37 answering the English survey and 10 answering the Spanish survey.

Findings: Parent Surveys

Tables for the English Parent Survey data are contained in **Appendix F** and for the Spanish Parent Survey data are contained in **Appendix G**. Following is a summary of the findings. In general, parents were very positive about YAF.

Q-1:

After attending the YAF, were you more determined than before to have your child attend a university?

67%

English Respondents: A vast majority (67%) reported that they were "most determined" while 21% reported they were "determined" for their child to attend a university.

70%

Spanish Respondents: The vast majority (70%) reported that they were "mas convencido" for their child to attend a university while 30% indicated they were "convencido" for their child to attend a university.





Q-2:

Do you feel the information offered at the YAF will better prepare your child to face the following challenges? 5 challenges were listed.

97%

English Respondents: 97% of the respondents reported that the information provided regarding financial assistance and interest and self-motivation would prepare their child to attend the university; while 94% reported that information regarding academic preparation was most influential.

Spanish Respondents: 100% of the respondents reported that the information provided would prepare their child to meet the first 4 challenges related to –"falta de dinero"; "preparacion academica"; and "proceso de matricula a la universidad" and "motivacion e interes propio".

Q-3:

What part of the YAF event was the most helpful to you in supporting your child to want to attend a university?

75%

English Respondents: 75% of the respondents felt that "opportunities/ resources available" were most helpful, while 62% of the respondents felt that "financial information" was considered helpful.

Spanish Respondents: 68% of respondents felt that "oportunidades y recursos disponibles" were most helpful. 66% felt that "oradores" were helpful while 33% felt that "procesos para la matricula a la universidad" were helpful for their child to attend a university.

Q-4:

Overall how helpful was the information presented today at the YAF in helping you support your child to want to attend a university?

67% English Responden

English Respondents: All respondents reported that the information presented was helpful, with 67% reporting that the information was "extremely helpful", 32% "very helpful". No parent felt that the information was not helpful.

60%

Spanish Respondents: 60% of respondents felt that the information was "de maxima utilidad" and 40% felt that the information was "muy util" for supporting their child to attend a university.

Q-5:

Would you recommend YAF to other parents and their children?

English Respondents: 36 parents reported that they would recommend the YAF to other parents and their children. One parent skipped this question.

Spanish Respondents: All 10 parents reported that they would recommend the YAF to other parents and their children.

Q-5:

What is your highest level of education?

English Respondents: Of 36 respondents, 33% reported graduating from a university, 19% graduated from community college, 13% reported some university course work and 16% reported some community college course work.

Spanish Respondents: 30% of respondents had completed "high school", 20% reported having completed "some university course work 20% earned "a university degree", and one respondent earned a "master's degree".

Overall Recommendations

- **1** The structure of the one-day event, the Young Achievers Forum, is very effective for the intended purpose: to inspire and motivate sixth graders to pursue a university career. 72% of the students were inspired by the large session motivational speakers and activities. 55% were positively impacted by the workshop speakers and 97% expressed that the days activities did motivate them to attend a university. In addition, 97% to 100% of parents responded that the YAF activities would motivate/inspire/help their child to attend a university. The YAF, as structured, does resonate with sixth grade students.
- 2 The YAF should be continued as it is providing "the" opportunity to positively impact the identified students. This is evident from survey data:

a. for 32% of the students attending the 2020 YAF, this was their first experience in a university campus;

b. while 50% reported that they had chosen a career to study, a large percentage,
41%, indicated that they were undecided about their career choice. Thus, the
YAF needs to continue providing its extensive menu of career opportunities to all
students. While students at this age may appear to be "decided" on a career choice,
it is still important to expand their knowledge to as many careers as possible. YAF
needs to be more innovative in selecting the careers presented to students;

c. 96% of the students indicated that the YAF motivated them to go to a university;

d. 98% of the students were very willing to recommend the YAF to their friends;

e. 100% of the parents surveyed indicated that the YAF created a positive impact for pursuing a university degree and 100% would recommend the YAF to other parents and their children.

3 While there are other competing well-established programs in the community that provide activities to raise awareness of university professions, the YAF attendees are from a student population that may be minimally recognized as having the potential to succeed. The YAF needs to not only continue providing support in this area, organizers need to explore sponsoring other yearlong YAF activities as 96% of students responded that they would be interested in participating in more YAF activities throughout the year. Additionally, parents are willing to have their children continue throughout the year with YAF activities, as 100% of them provided contact information for follow-up.



While the major goal of the YAF is to motivate six grade students to understand and gain knowledge in selecting and completing a university degree, there is another potential expansion to the YAF activities. This is the inclusion of the community college that offers transitional programs to many university careers. The community college could offer another dimension for students succeeding in university degree completion.

- As difficult as it is to enlist the parents of sixth grade level students to attend school events, YAF holds promise in attracting more parents to its events. Organizers need to explore other ideas to increase parent participation. Sponsoring parents that have already attended YAF to have them recruit other parents for the annual YAF event might be helpful. In addition, raffles, door prizes, and certificates of recognition can gain the interest of parents who might be reluctant to attend.
- **6** The student registration system and the actual attendance documentation system need to be better aligned and the actual data shared among the YAF organizers. The data captured for the 2020 YAF indicated that 793 students registered for the event and 547 were in attendance. While this has been the trend, that more students register than show up, a total of 584 surveys were collected by the evaluation team. This is 37 more respondents that were in attendance. Somehow from 1 to 2 groups of students were not accounted for in the attendance documentation.



Summary

This report has been prepared for the purpose of capturing the overall impact of the Young Achievers Forum and offering recommendations for its continuation, improvement, and expansion.
